# Conditionality Update

- Removal of answer “NO” in key hs-fir-30 as a condition to make HS-FIR-6 (-1 to -7) visible.
- HS-FIR-6 (hs-fir-32) is only visible if:
  - hs-fir-30 (*Are arrangements in case of medical emergency, including on-site medical facilities/clinic(s) and staff in line with legal requirements?*) has a YES or No applicable legal requirements answer
- Section: HEALTH & SAFETY
- Sub-section: First Aid and Medical
- Category: Medical Treatment
- Updated keys: hs-fir-33x, hs-fir-34x, hs-fir-35x, hs-fir-36x, hs-fir-37x, hs-fir-38x, hs-fir-39x
